

SPANISH (SPAN)

SPAN 101: First Year Spanish I (4)

Students will begin to build the basic skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing in Spanish, with a special focus on communicating. Students will be introduced to the diversity of the Spanish-speaking world.

Registration-Enforced Prerequisite: WR 115 or higher with a grade of C or better.

Terms Typically Offered: Fall

SPAN 102: First Year Spanish II (4)

Students will further develop the basic skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing. The course emphasizes oral communication and listening comprehension within a culturally authentic context. Students will deepen their awareness of the Spanish-speaking world.

Registration-Enforced Prerequisite: WR 115 or higher and SPAN 101 with a grade of C or better.

Terms Typically Offered: Winter

SPAN 103: First Year Spanish III (4)

Students will practice active communication while strengthening speaking, reading, writing, and listening skills within a culturally authentic context. Through the study of literature and other media, students will deepen their awareness of the Spanish-speaking world.

Registration-Enforced Prerequisite: WR 115 or higher and SPAN 102 with a grade of C or better.

Terms Typically Offered: Spring, Summer

SPAN 122: Spanish for Safety Personnel (4)

This course will introduce students to basic Spanish vocabulary and phrases pertinent to safety, emergency, and medical personnel. Identifies when and how to use this language in culturally appropriate ways, and explains how differing attitudes and beliefs can impact cross-cultural interactions in emergency and medical settings

Terms Typically Offered: Spring

SPAN 201: Second Year Spanish I (4)

This course promotes intensive development of oral and written Spanish language skills. Students will review and expand on first-year structural patterns and vocabulary by integrating listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. In-depth exploration of cultures is offered through the use of authentic materials from the Spanish-speaking world. Conducted in Spanish.

Registration-Enforced Prerequisite: SPAN 103 with a grade of C or better.

Terms Typically Offered: Fall

SPAN 202: Second Year Spanish II (4)

This course continues an in-depth development of oral and written Spanish language skills with further emphasis on vocabulary and complex grammatical concepts. In-depth exploration of cultures is offered through the use of authentic materials from the Spanish-speaking world. Conducted in Spanish.

Registration-Enforced Prerequisite: SPAN 201 with a grade of C or better.

Terms Typically Offered: Winter

SPAN 203: Second Year Spanish III (4)

This course promotes continued development of Spanish language skills through in-depth oral activities and discussion of themes, analysis of current events relating to the Spanish-speaking world; and the use of written materials as a means of communication. In-depth exploration of cultures is offered through use of authentic materials from the Spanish-speaking world. Conducted in Spanish.

Registration-Enforced Prerequisite: SPAN 202 with a grade of C or better.

Terms Typically Offered: Spring
