# CHILD HEALTH AND WELLBEING CERTIFICATE

## **Program Description**

The Child Health and Wellbeing (CHWB) Micro-credential encompasses a comprehensive curriculum that includes child health, cultural competence, supporting children with differing abilities, guiding behaviors, and trauma-responsive practices for children aged 0-8.

### **Program Outcomes**

After students complete this certificate they will be able to:

- Identify appropriate learning environments based on child development in the context of trauma informed and culturally responsive practices.
- Identify appropriate strategies to effectively connect, engage, and support families with children who are experiencing developmental delays and/or disabilities.
- Develop appropriate assessment in partnership with families to create strength-based approaches in supporting children's social and emotional development.
- Select developmentally, culturally, and linguistically appropriate techniques to connect children and families in development and learning.
- Identify trauma responsive strategies to design, implement, and evaluate social and emotional development and comprehensive developmental learning outcomes each individual child.
- Describe professional behavior reflective of ethical guidelines and professional practices in early childhood education.

### **Career Considerations**

The Child Health and Wellbeing Micro credential is designed for current and future early childhood care and education professionals who want in-depth knowledge of how to support children's social-emotional development with an emphasis on supporting children with diverse backgrounds, special needs, and/or children who have experienced traumatic experiences. Students who complete this micro-credential will earn 150 professional development hours that can be applied to the Oregon Registry Steps and knowledge that supports a career in Early Childhood Care and Education, Early Childhood Special Education, Early Intervention, and Home Visiting.
